

Draft Vision and Objectives as at 26 July 2017

Vision

South Cerney will, in the period to 2031, uphold its balance of historical buildings and features alongside newer developments and will retain its vibrancy, individuality and community spirit. The sustainability of the parish will be enhanced by developing a stronger network of facilities and services whilst ensuring that the character and landscape is conserved and enhanced.

Objectives

- Supporting sustainable developments which conserve and enhance the character and landscape of the parish
- Maintaining the separation of the parish from Cirencester, Siddington and Preston
- Sustaining and improving local facilities and services
- Strengthening and supporting economic development, particularly for local people and businesses
- Ensuring that developments do not increase the risk of flooding, including groundwater flooding, at other locations
- Ensuring that business development is located within the designated Business Park area where appropriate
- Ensuring that there is adequate provision for parking and appropriate traffic flow for all future developments
- Seek on-going improvements to the network of public transport, footpaths and cycle ways
- Enhancing greenspace, the landscape and supporting nature conservation and improving access to lakeside areas
