

South Cerney NDP Household Questionnaire 2017 Comment Analysis

Introduction

During winter 2016/17 a community consultation was carried out through the distribution of a questionnaire to all households within South Cerney Parish to determine the community's views on priorities for the future of South Cerney Parish.

GRCC received a total of 401 responses via paper copies. Please note that although the total number of questionnaire comments analysed were 316, many respondents covered multiple points in their comments.

Comments have been analysed by grouping recurring themes and where relevant sub-themes are also listed
